## NON-AVAILABILITY OF AMENDED ANNEX "J" AND ANNEX "H-I" NOTIFIED THROUGH SRO 55(I)/2025

Recently, the Federal Board of Revenue has amended the Sales Tax Rules, 2006 through SRO No. 55(I)/2025 dated 24 January 2025, introducing significant changes in the filing of Sales Tax Returns. Specifically, it mandates the filing of Annex "J" by all registered manufacturers and Annex "H-I" by all registered commercial importers, distributors, and wholesalers making supply of goods. These changes are expected to take effect immediately in the return for the Tax Period "January 2025".

In this regard, the Karachi Tax Bar Association would like to express its grave concern that, as of today, the amend Annex "J" and Annex "H-I" have not yet been incorporated into the Sales Tax Return. The non-availability of these annexures is a significant issue, and with the compliance deadline for filing of Sales Tax Return for the Tax Period of "January 2025" is fast approaching, it may lead to considerable hardship for taxpayers in filing their sales tax returns.

In light of this, we propose that the implementation of SRO No. 55/2025 be suspended for two tax periods i.e. upto Tax Period "March 2025", allowing the taxpayers sufficient time to understand and comply with the new requirements.
